ALL SEED should be delivered to CSU no later than **January 30, 2021**. (week 4) Please arrange to have rooted cuttings delivered to CSU during February (Weeks 5-9) and 4" plants delivered during March (Weeks 9-13) 2021.

*We are unable to root cuttings at our University Greenhouse due to our lack of propagation facilities. If at all possible send rooted cuttings. If you are only able to send unrooted cuttings we can work with you to find a rooting station in Colorado.
